
Ten Years of Making Transformational Change

Improve Your Tomorrow (IYT) was founded in 2013 with the mission to increase the number of young men of color (YMOC) to attend and graduate from colleges and universities. We envision a world in which young men of color are overrepresented in higher education, underrepresented in the criminal justice system, and are leaders in their communities.

For the last ten years, the IYT has operated programs within Sacramento schools, helping create transformational change in the lives of thousands of young men of color through their 7-12th grade program, College Academy. Having started with only 17 members and one school, Improve Your Tomorrow now serves over 4,000 members across 68 school-based sites in Northern and Central California. While IYT has expanded to serve youth in the Bay Area and Central Vally, Sacramento remains the organizations largest region, with 60% of it's membership living within the Sacramento-Metro area.

By the Numbers: IYT's Impact FY 21-22

Despite the impact that COVID has had on educational attainment, IYT members continue to experienced increases across key academic outcomes. Our latest year of data (FY21-22) showed Black members were 25% more likely to graduate high school and 26% more likely to complete A-G course requirements than their state peers. Additionally, IYT's Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander members were 34% more likely to complete A-G course requirements. Lastly, IYT's Hispanic and Latino members were 30% more likely to complete A-G course requirements and 21% more likely to go college.




